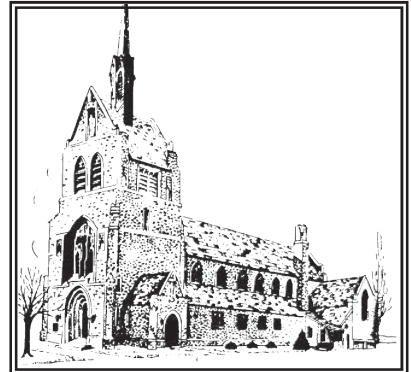

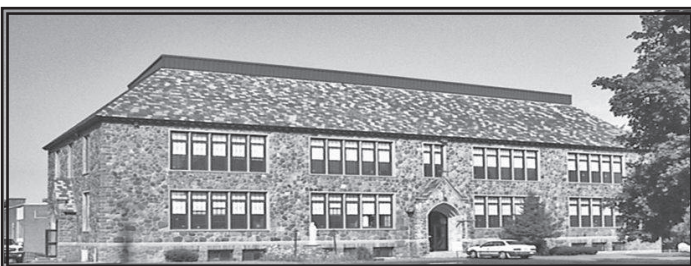

Each year, as Thanksgiving approaches, we observe our annual Stewardship Sunday. It's important to remember that all our possessions are ultimately a "gift," something received from God and for which we ought to be thankful. It begins with the life we have received, without which we literally have nothing at all. Other gifts to be counted are the "internal resources" we possess, such as energy, intelligence, and talents. Choosing to put these into practice (or not) makes a big difference in how well (or poorly) we do in life. We typically number our gifts in the "Three T's" - Time, Talent, Treasure.

This is a good way to start: we all have our "allotment" of gifts in time, talent, and treasure. As Christians, we really should recognize that God is the giver of all these things - we're simply caretakers (stewards) of them. As an act of ongoing thanksgiving for these gifts, we really must put our time, talent, and treasure to use in the service of God and neighbor.

ADDITIONALLY, there's a gift we have which is not one of the "Three T's" - our Faith. So ask yourself: how much effort do I put into learning and practicing my Faith, developing my relationship with Christ? This is a gift beyond measure that often gets taken for granted - as part of our stewardship Sunday this weekend, in addition to Time, Talent and Treasure, we're offering opportunities for commitment to some concrete steps in cultivating our relationship with God and His Church.
